1. Asia-Europe Foundation



Asia-Europe Foundation (ASEF)

- Founded in 1997 (26 partners; 2018: 53)
- Inter-governmental not-for-profit organisation
- Only established institution of the **Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM)** process
- Physically based in Singapore
- Funded by annual voluntary contributions from the 53 ASEM partners

ASEF's Mandate

- Promote better **understanding** between Asians & Europeans
- Enable **exchanges** between people, institutions & organisations of Asia & Europe
- Organise & implement **projects** in Asia & Europe

(Dublin Agreed Principles, 1996; amended 2004)



ASEF's Thematic Areas



Over 25 projects per year

About 125 partners per year

More than 3,000 active participants per year

Reached many more through our events & online platforms

Sustainable consumption and production

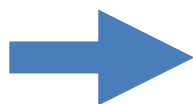

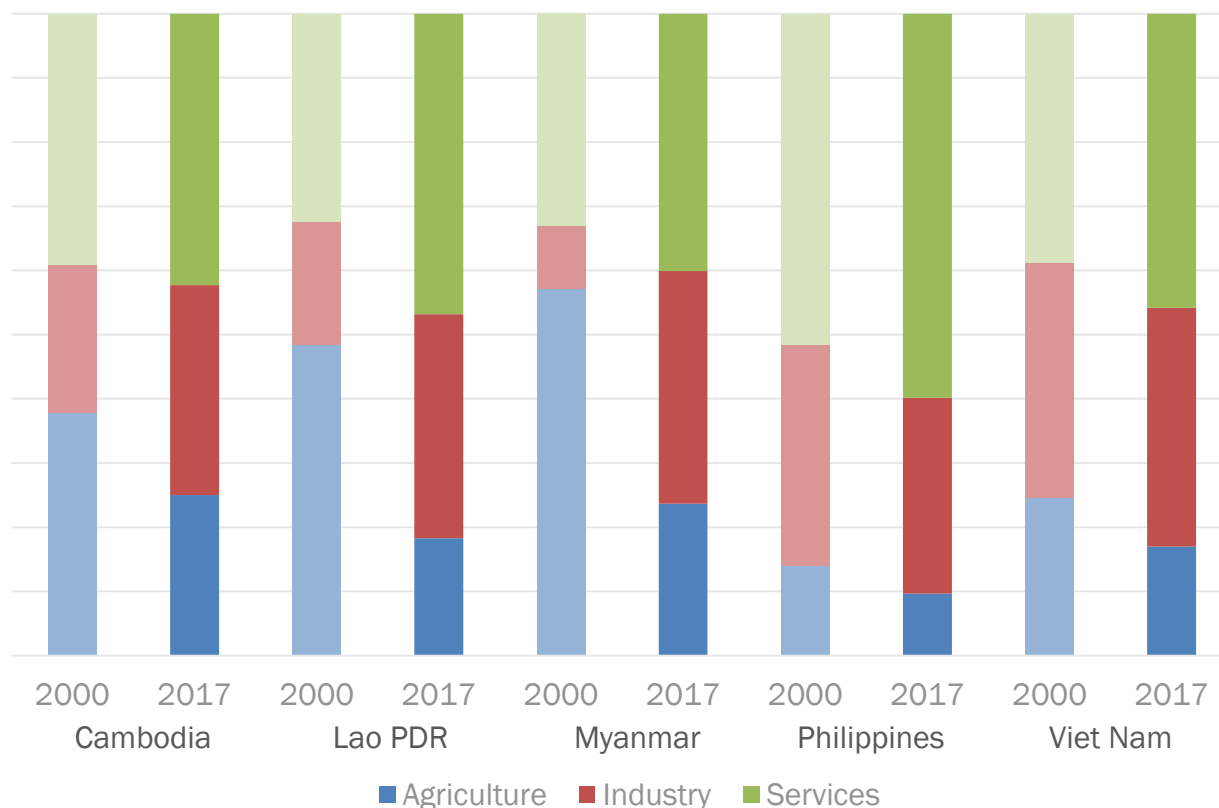

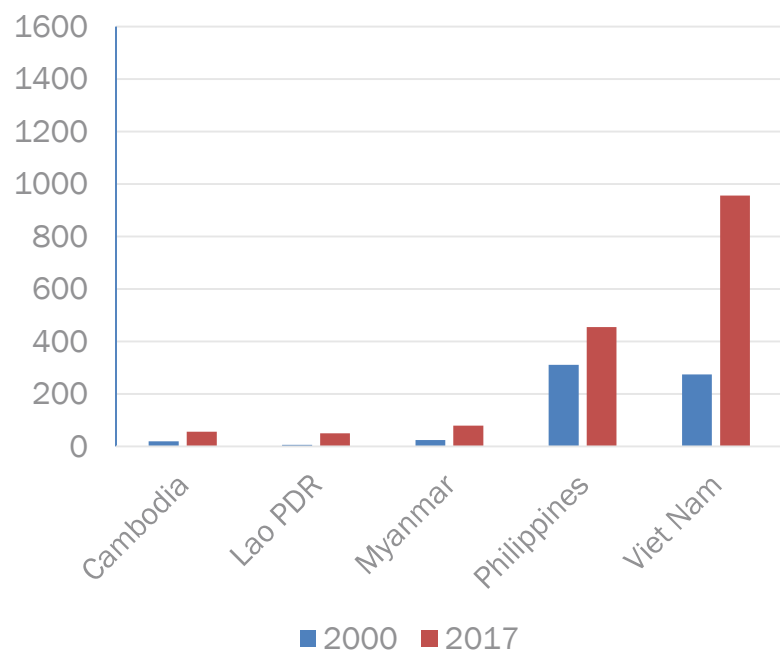
Structure of output, % of GDP



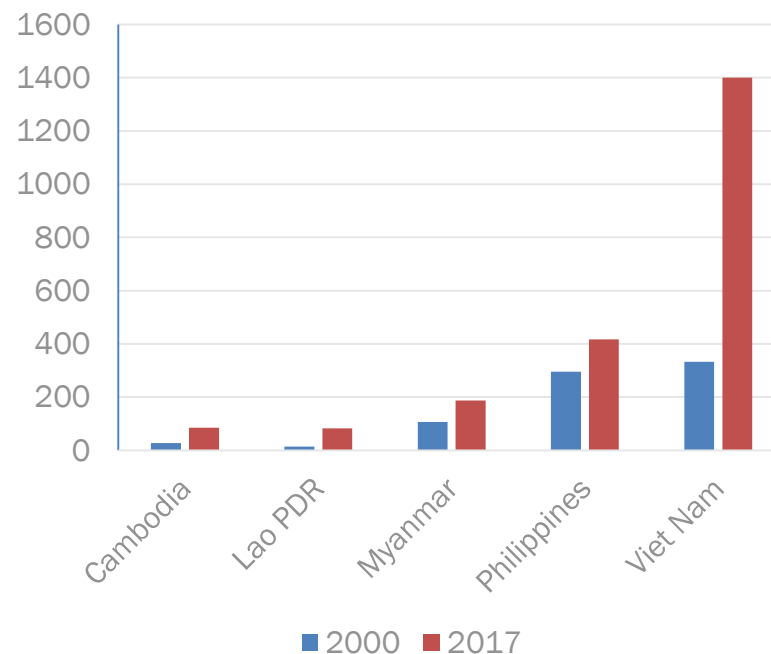
