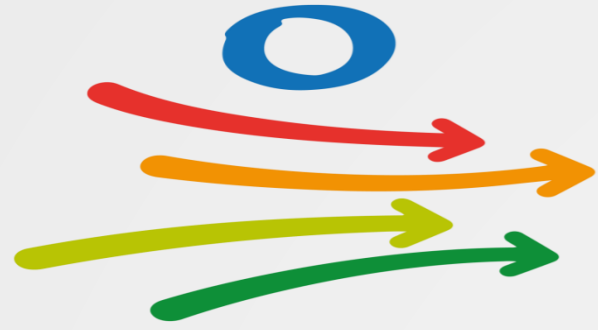

THE NATIONAL ACTION PLAN ON THE 2030 AGENDA (NAP)

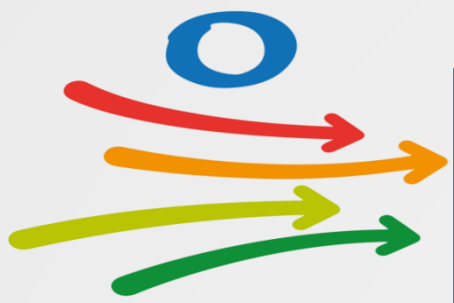
- The NAP has been approved and signed by Prime Minister in May 2017.
- The NAP proposes
 - 17 VSDGs
 - 115 targets





THE NATIONAL ACTION PLAN ON THE 2030 AGENDA (NAP)

- There are two phases of NAP implementation:
 - + From 2017 to 2020: focus on completing the policies to create a enable environment for VSDGs implementation.
 - + From 2021 to 2030: comprehensive implementation of measures, solutions to achieve VSDGs and targets.
- Clearly responsibilities of National Council on SD and Competiveness, ministries, sectors and provinces in implementing, monitoring and reporting VSDGs.
- Emphasizing the participation and mobilization of resources by all stakeholders for VSDGs implementation.



UPDATE INFORMATION ON NAP IMPLEMENTATION

- ❑ Establishment of an inter-ministerial working group on VSDGs, chaired by the Vice Minister of Planning and Investment.
- ❑ Developing action plans of ministries, sectors and provinces to implement the VSDGs.
- ❑ Developing a roadmap for achieving VSDGs.
- ❑ Developing the guideline for mainstreaming VSGDs into socio-economic development plans at central, sector and local levels.



UPDATE INFORMATION ON NAP IMPLEMENTATION

- ❑ Establishing a set of statistical indicators for VSDGs.
- ❑ Developing the guideline for monitoring and evaluating VSDGs.
- ❑ Strengthening awareness for stakeholders on SDGs.
- ❑ Mobilizing the participation of all stakeholders (especially social organizations, non-governmental organizations and the business community) in the implementation of VSDGs through workshops, online surveys and coordination with the UN SDGs working group.
- ❑ Preparing the Voluntary National Review (VNR) report to be presented at the United Nations High Level Political Forum (HLPF) in 2018.



THE CHALLENGES ON NAP IMPLEMENTATION

- ❑ Effectively mobilizing finance for VSDGs. Engage all stakeholders in VSDGs implementation and left no one behind.
- ❑ Mainstreaming VSDGs into national, sectoral and local plans, master plans, strategies.
- ❑ Affordable system of Monitoring and Evaluating for VSDGs.



RECOMMENDATION

- ❑ Strengthening mobilization of Finance and other resources for VSDGs:
 - Promoting mainstreaming VSDGs implementation into current national target programs
 - Prioritize domestic resources for VSDGs implementing
 - Create affordable mechanism to effectively attract all stakeholders, especially private sector to invest for VSDGs
- ❑ Enhancing statistical capacity to make the database and indicators for VSDGs as comprehensive as possible
- ❑ Promoting the partnership for VSDGs
 - Promoting the roles of community, civil society, the private sector, academia
 - Strengthening exchange knowledge, sciences and technologies with international communities
