### 1. Human Rights- Disadvantaged Children July 15<sup>th</sup>- August 7<sup>th</sup>

<b>Country</b>	Vietnam
<b>Organisation</b>	Volunteers For Peace Vietnam (VPV)

<b>Workcamp</b>	Vietnam Friendship Village is a treatment/care centre for Agent Orange victims located in Ha Tay Province, which was opened in 1993 to treat children and veterans suffering from the effects of Agent Orange (The children, whose fathers or grandfathers were exposed (causing chromosomal damage) or who were contaminated from their mother's milk, suffer from a range of difficult conditions. While staying in Vietnam Friendship Village, children and veterans are nourished and are provided with free medical care. The children, who may stay there for several years, receive not only basic education, but also some forms of job training.
<b>Project visit</b>	Volunteers will be able to participate in the camp for disadvantaged children, and also participate in helping rural children who have limited opportunities for intercultural learning.

### 2. Education July 15<sup>th</sup>- August 7<sup>th</sup>

<b>Country</b>	Indonesia
<b>Organization</b>	Indonesia International Work Camp

<b>Workcamp</b>	This project will concern with the education of the street children living in Tandang Community. Volunteers will organize additional English lesson and other subjects for the children, visit schools for possibility of scholarship to some local schools nearby the settlement, work on skill development for the children, teach personal health and sanitation, and so on. Accommodation: Host family, sleeping bag is needed, self cooking.
<b>Project visit</b>	1) The local NGOs we are cooperating together for the street children project for education and skill development issues. 2) Environment education project by visiting another work camp 3) Visiting MTV project side of UDINUS for assisting English teacher and helping the students with their daily conversation in English.

<b>Organization</b>	SJ Vietnam

<b>Workcamp</b>	The volunteers will help SJ Viet Nam to run a new small school as Youth House Street Children School set up by local and international volunteers for street children and poor children at Fisher village. The volunteers will organize campaign to encourage the children go to the school and will organize leisure activities for them everyday.

3. Environment

<b>Country</b>	Italy
<b>Organisation</b>	Youth Action for Peace (YAP) Italy

<b>Workcamp</b>	Odoardina is a centre belonging to Zora social cooperative. It hosts about 20 disabled people (aged 20 to 35) during the day, except weekends. For a few years international volunteers have been working with them in the summer, mainly outside. The idea behind the projects is that sustainable and environment friendly agriculture can be used as a tool for the integration of disabled people, can be used as successful means of fundraising and can promote the political concepts NGOs support by demonstrating their feasibility in local realities.
<b>Project visit</b>	We want to arrange meetings with Legambiente and WWF Italian headquarters which are located in Rome.

August 8<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup>

<b>Country</b>	Greece
<b>Organisation</b>	Conservation Volunteers Greece

<b>Workcamp</b>	Volunteers are going to work in the Monastery of St. Panteleimon with several tasks of light construction/ restoration work at first. The monastery, build in 1475, today runs as a guest house for visitors. Volunteers are going to work on the precinct and restore an old water mill. They are also going to water oaks and pistachios recently planted; they will do conservation works and place signs at footpaths and they are going to clean a near by coast.
<b>Project visit</b>	Volunteers will work in several villages of the municipality where they will clean the vegetation of footpaths and restore the footpaths' signs. They will also clean the beaches of the area and help with the fire watching in shifts. The work of volunteers will be a great help for the municipalities that were ruined after the catastrophic fires in summer of 2006.

#### 4. Conflict Resolution- Refugees/ Immigrants July 15<sup>th</sup> - August 7<sup>th</sup>

<b>Country</b>	Belgium
<b>Organisation</b>	VIAvzw

<b>Workcamp</b>	Ter Dennen is a Red Cross centre for asylum seekers. After arrival in Belgium refugees are sent to this kind of center where they get food and a shelter. Ter Dennen is a quite isolated place in a green surrounding with about 200 people (also children) from more then 20 countries.

<b>Workcamp</b>	This camp is a trilateral project with the theme of Refugees. The French, together with other international volunteers from the introduction meeting and one family of asylum seekers will be spending some time together in the Beautiful hosting center in the French Alps. The French volunteers will invite one refugee family at SJ PACA to have summer holidays by living with the volunteers, and go hiking for example.
<b>Project visit</b>	The volunteers will have the opportunity to visit some of the asylum seekers centers as well as other projects related with the theme.
