Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

General Enquiries

How can I apply?

You can apply through the [ASEFJS12 Application Form](#)

Who is eligible to apply?

Participants have to meet the following criteria:

- be under 35 years old
- be a citizen of an [ASEM Partner country](#)
- be currently employed as a journalist or media professional (traditional media, online media, freelance are all eligible)
- have experience and/or projects on the topic of media trust, misinformation and disinformation

What is the deadline to apply?

We will accept applications until **0200H GMT** on **16 September 2019**

How are participants selected?

We aim to have a representative selection of participants from the 51 ASEM Partner Countries

We adopt a non-discriminatory approach ensuring gender balance and fair access to all. In doing so, we treat all applicants equally, regardless of race, national origin (ancestry), gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, pregnancy, disability, religion (creed) or marital status.

In addition, participants will be selected on the basis of their involvement and experience in the topic of media trust, misinformation and other related areas.

When will I know if I've been selected?

Applicants will be informed of the results from **30 September 2019** onwards

Are there any additional programmes?

Participants may participate in the following supplementary activities: Media Coverage of ASEMFMM14 side events such as the [ASEM Cultural Festival \(#ASEMfest\)](#) and [9th Model ASEM](#).

Fees

Will I have to pay any fees to participate? There are no fees involved. ASEFJS12 is fully funded.

Travel

Who pays for the travel costs? All participants will receive a travel subsidy **in the form of reimbursement** after the event, provided all relevant documents are submitted.

Participants are expected to first book their own travels.

Please refer to *Conditions of Subsidy* for all the details.

Are visa fees covered? Your travel subsidy also includes travel insurance, expenses related to visa procurement and airport transfers between the port of arrival in Madrid and the conference hotel.

Accommodation & meals

Will accommodation be provided? The organisers will provide single-room accommodation for 3 nights (check-in 12 December, check-out 15 December) for all participants.

How about meals? All meals will be provided during the programme (13-14 December).

Participants covering and accredited for the 14th ASEM Foreign Ministers' Meeting (ASEMFMM14) on 15-16 December will need to cover their own accommodation and expenses by themselves.
