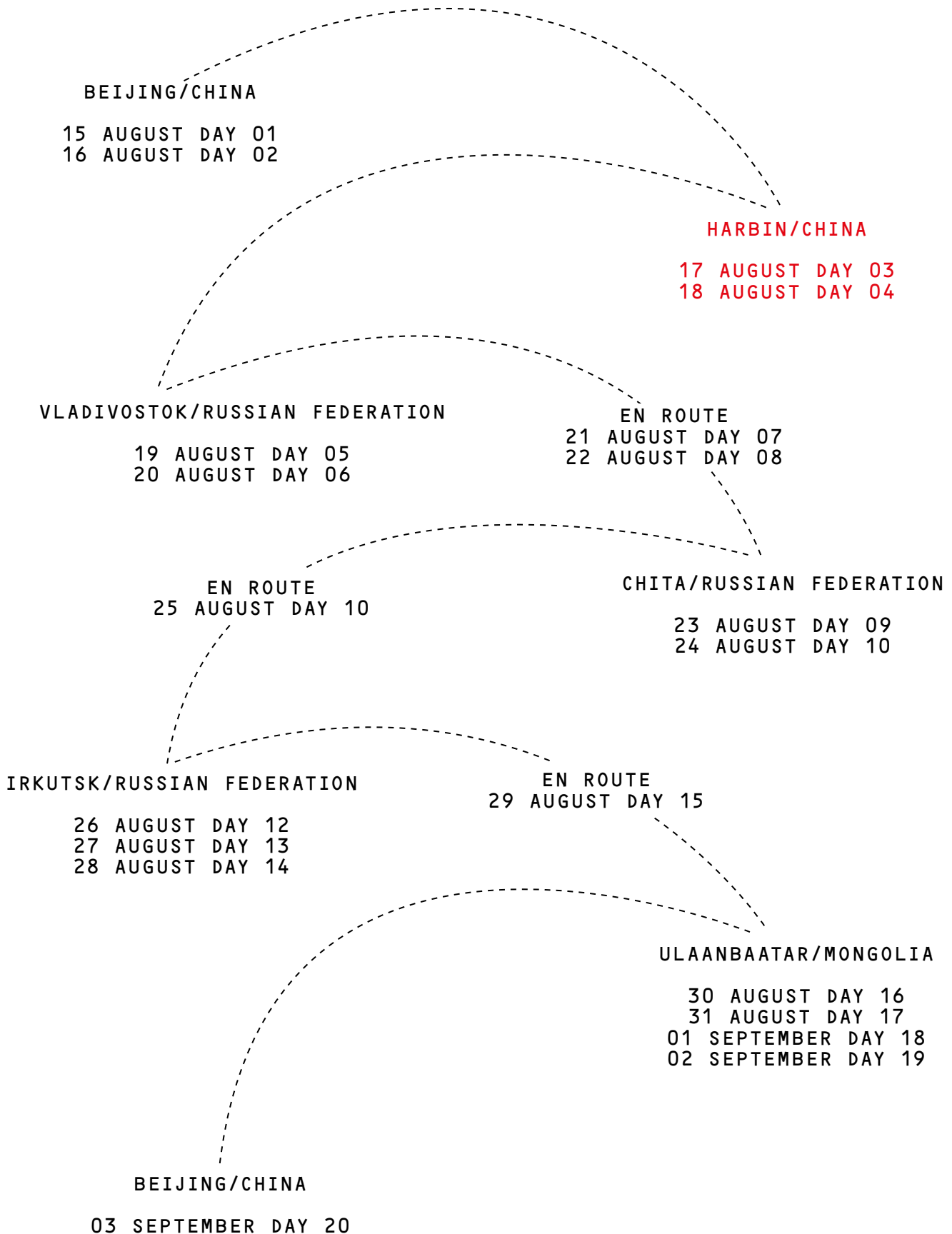

## Programme for Harbin, China 17 August – 18 August 2016
