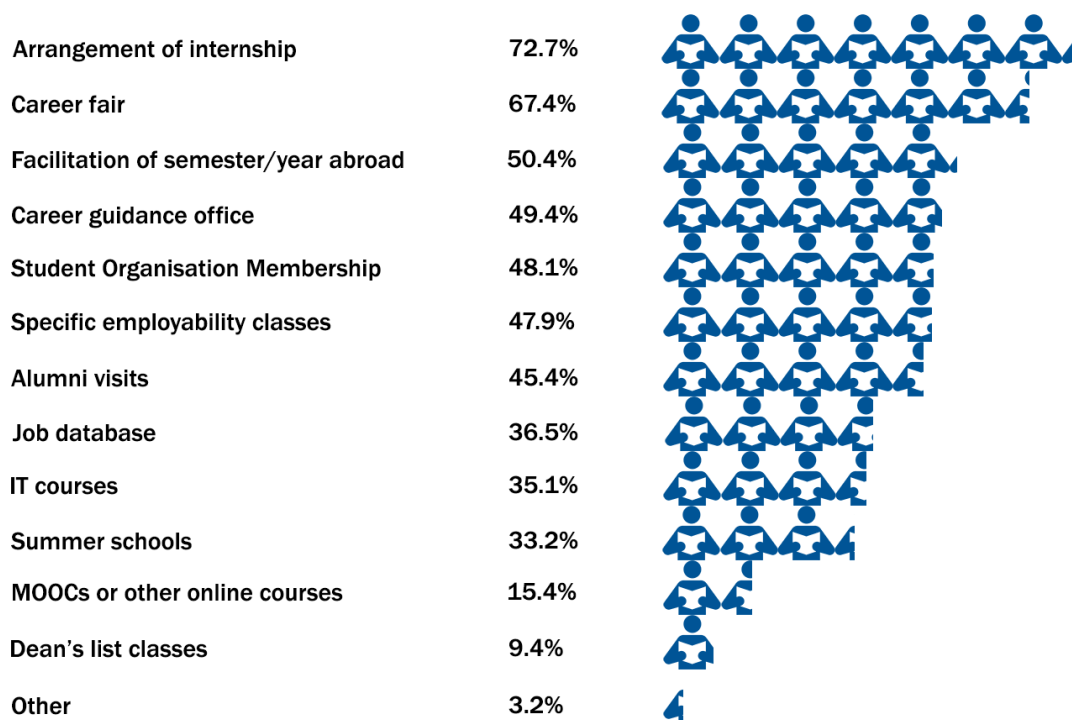

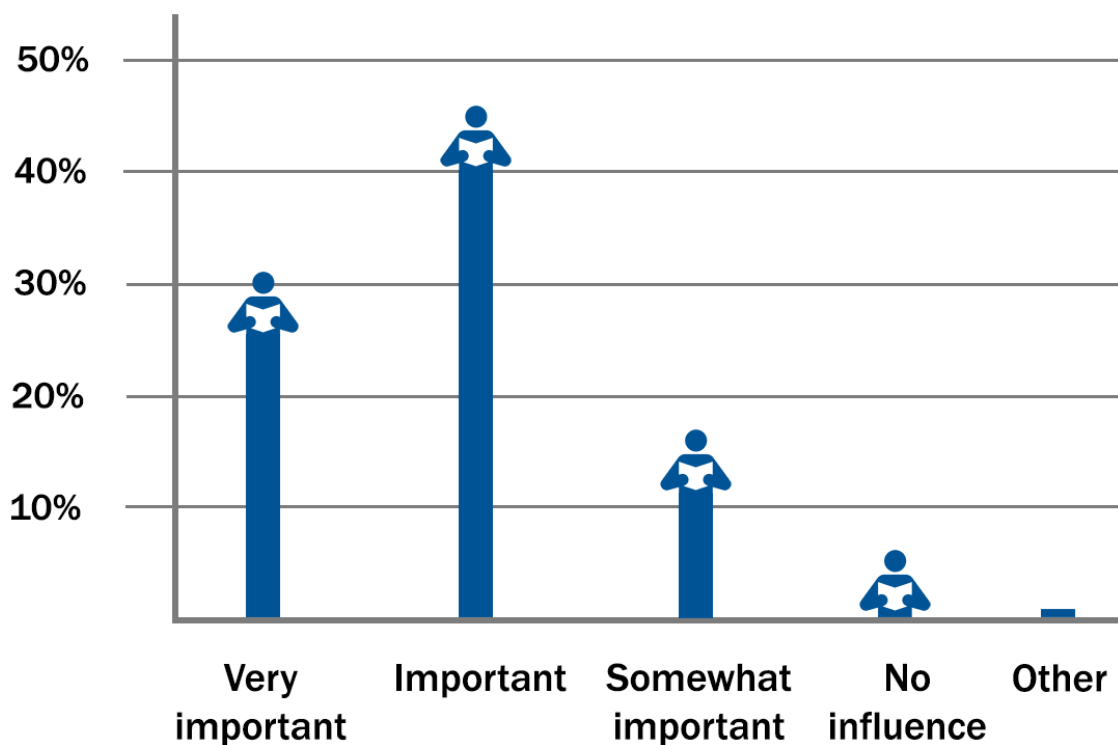
Each participant was asked to indicate what their university offers to help students find a job. Multiple answers could be ticked.

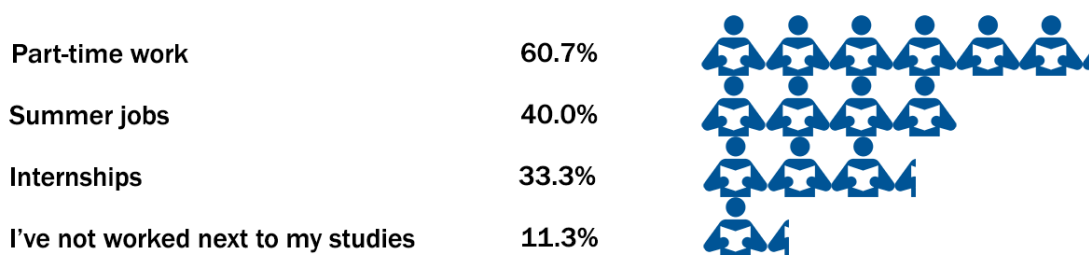

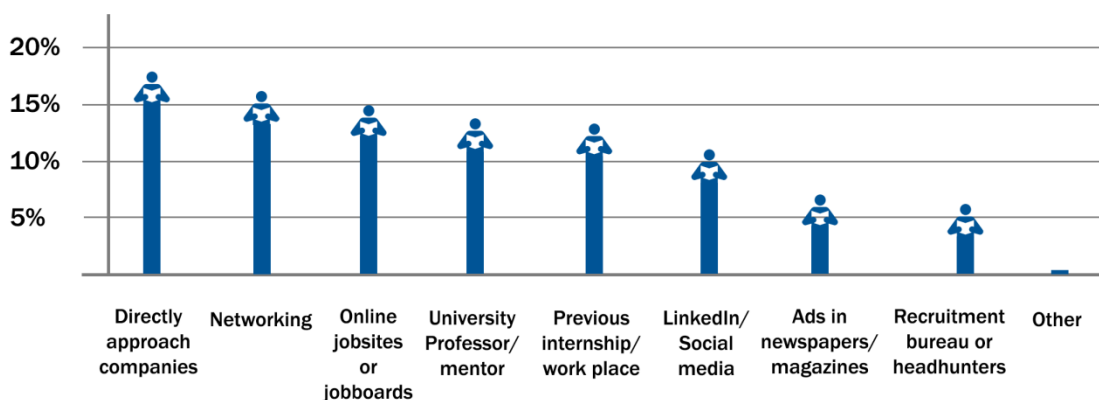

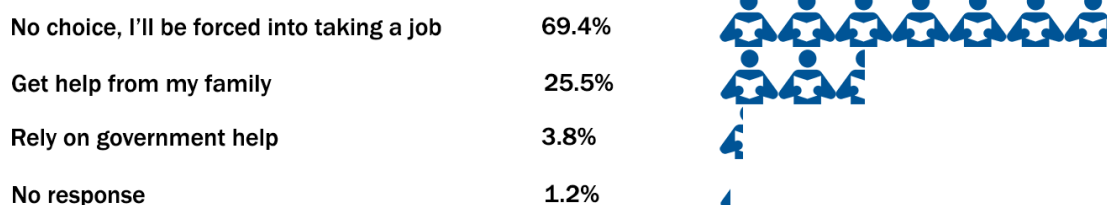

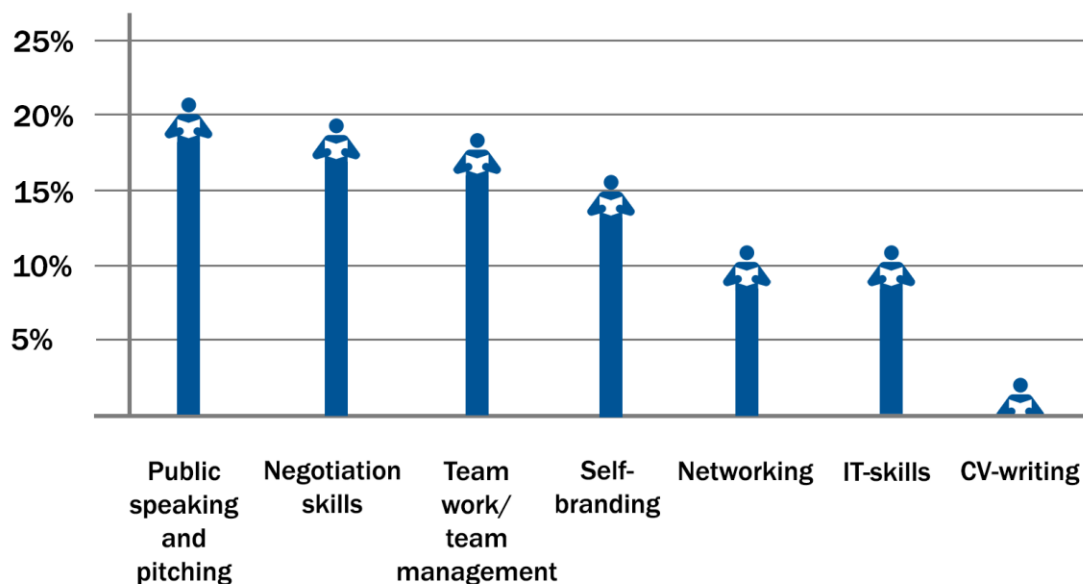
Each participant was asked to indicate how they would survive financially if they wouldn't find a job immediately after graduation.

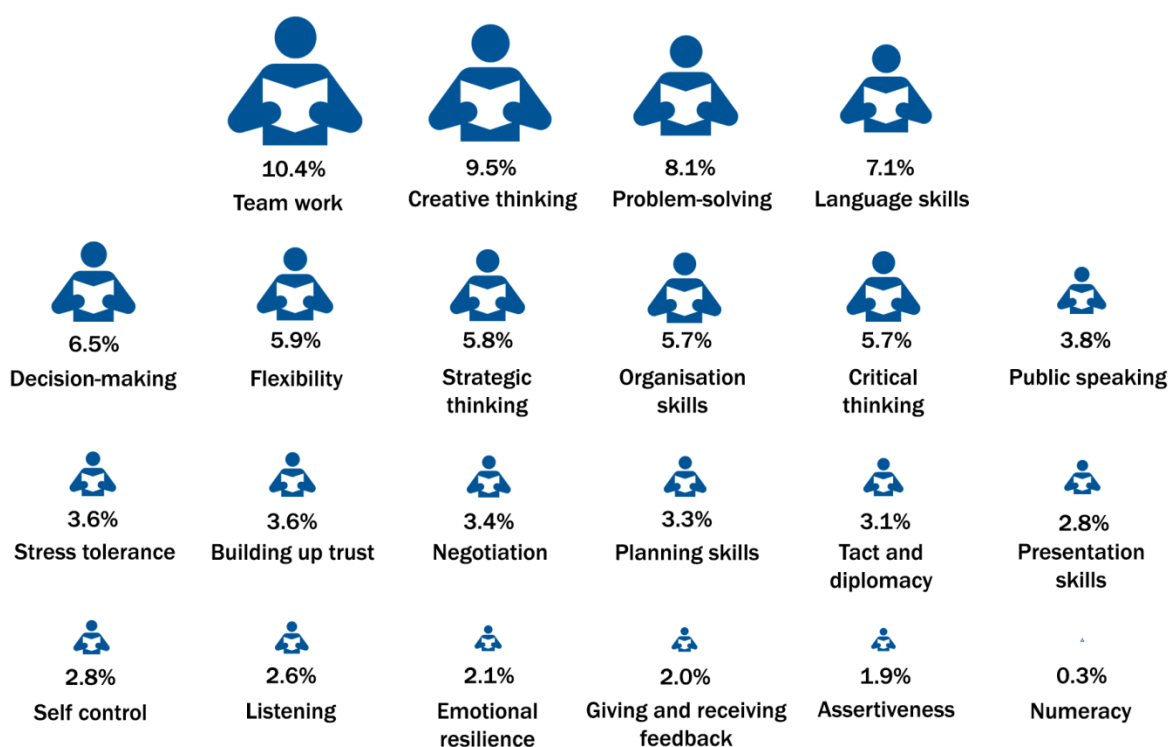
