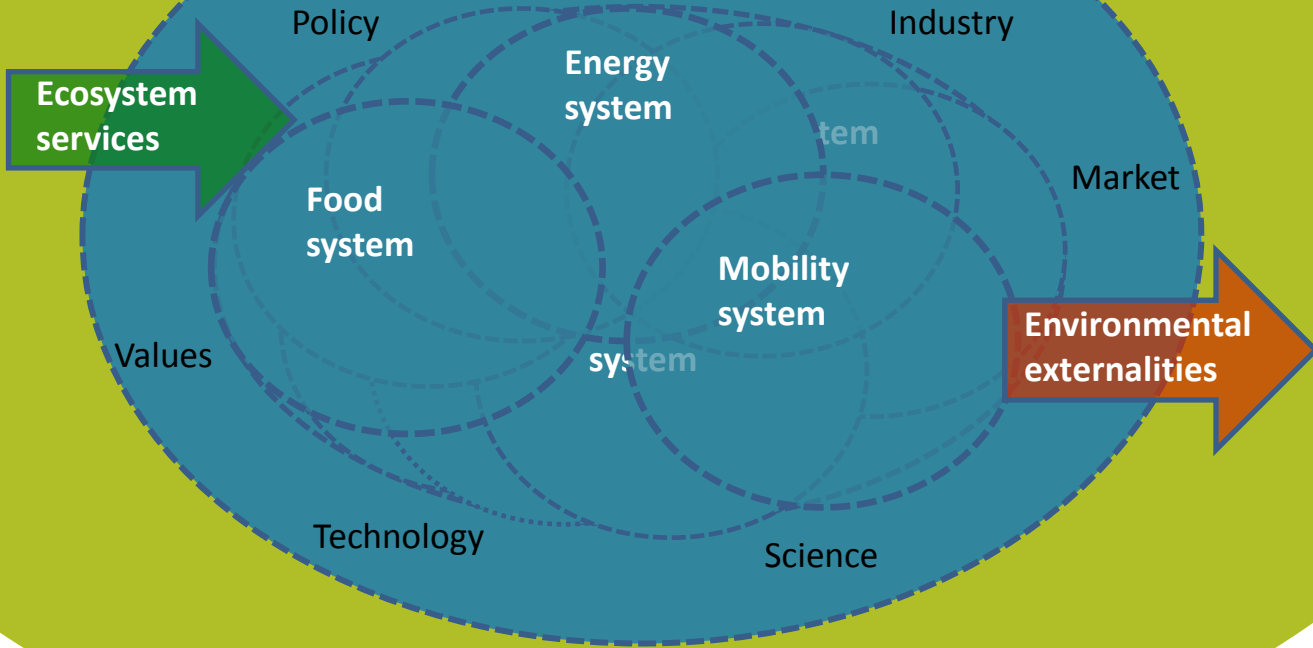

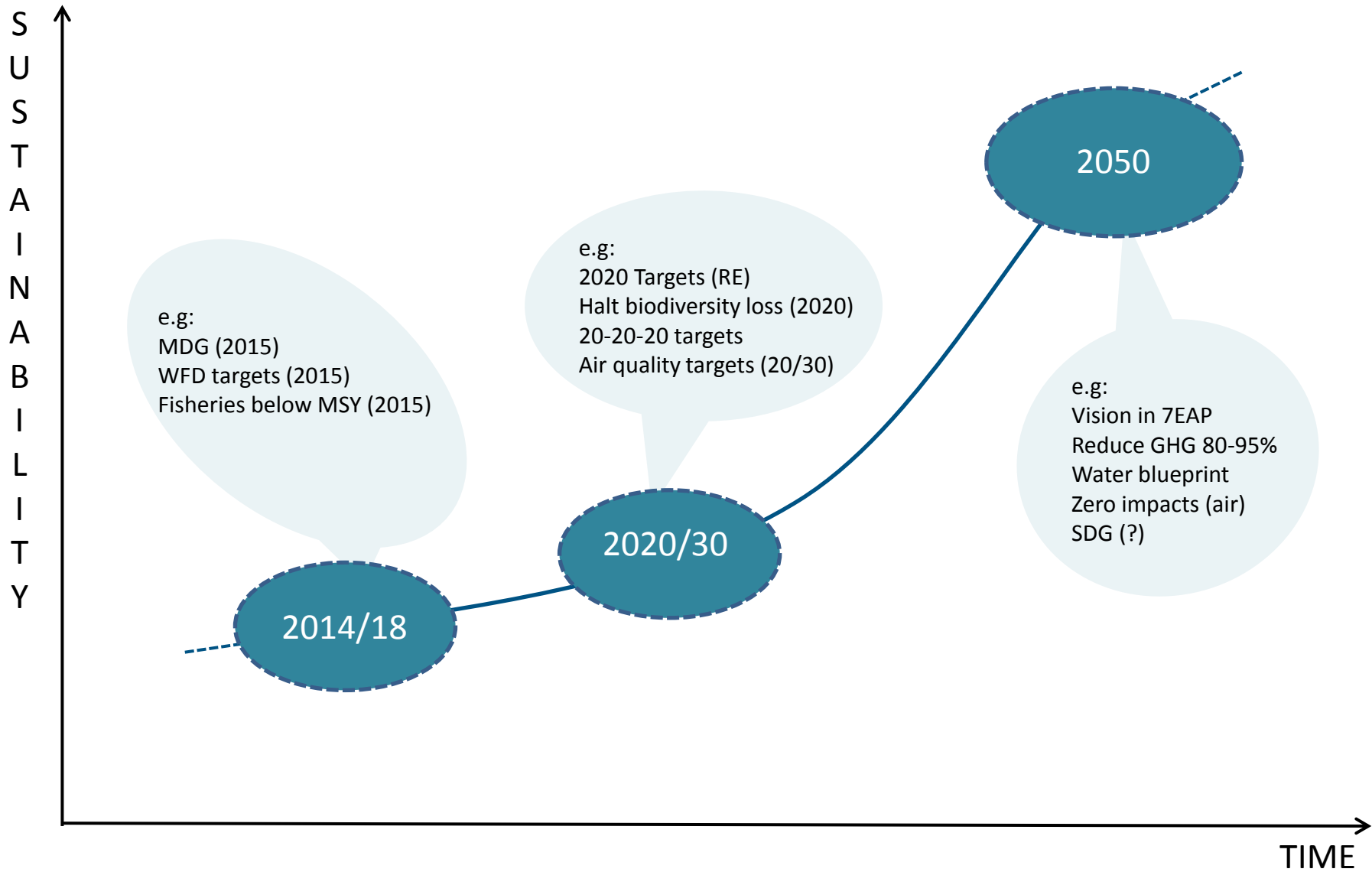

meeting social needs and providing value





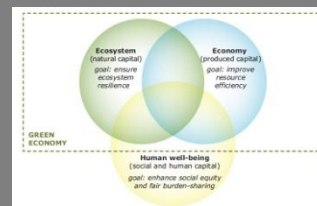
## “Resilience”
