
ASEF'S participation in the 3rd Steering Committee Meeting for Global Health Security Agenda (GHSA)

17 November 2021



Remarks by ASEF Executive Director Amb. MORIKAWA Toru

A good morning, good afternoon and good evening, depending on where you are! Thank you very much for this opportunity to speak at GHSA SGM. My name is MORIKAWA Toru, I am Executive Director of the Asia-Europe Foundation (ASEF). It is my great pleasure to meet you virtually. First of all, I would like to express my sincere gratitude for your acceptance for ASEF to become a member of GHSA this year. We are delighted to be part of the effort fighting against pandemics.

Let me share about the Asia-Europe Foundation and our Public Health Network. The Asia-Europe Foundation (ASEF) is the sole permanently established institution of the Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) process. ASEM has 53 Partners, including 51 partner countries, plus the ASEAN Secretariat, and the European Union. ASEF promotes greater mutual understanding between Asia and Europe through intellectual, cultural and people-to-people exchanges. ASEF has 7 thematic areas of common concern of Asia and Europe, such as Climate Change and human rights, and Public Health is one of these key themes at ASEF.

The thematic area "Public Health" is called ASEF Public Health Network, or ASEF PHN. It is part of the ASEM Initiative for the Rapid Containment of Pandemic Influenza, officially launched in 2009 with the financial support of the Government of Japan. The initiative also has a stockpile project – PPE and other items get delivered in case of Public Health Emergencies. ASEF PHN promotes a bi-regional exchange of public health priorities with a strong focus on emerging infectious diseases (EIDs), including pandemics, such as COVID-19. We provide a platform to facilitate multi-sector knowledge sharing among ASEM Partners.

In April this year, ASEF PHN organised an online roundtable, "Pandemic and the Economy – investment for the future", which connected us with GHSA. We facilitated a much-needed dialogue on sustainable financing related to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, bridging officials from the health and non-health sectors together. The roundtable promoted the concept "the best economic strategy is to control pandemic" via intersectoral collaboration for better financial preparedness for future pandemics.

Upon joining GHSA in June this year, ASEF has joined in Action Package for Sustainable Financing for Preparedness. ASEF also joined to Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) Action Package, as we have been working on AMR since 2018. Using our unique strength linking the health and non-health sectors in combatting public health threats, ASEF is committed to continuing contributing to GHSA, especially in the area of sustainable financing and AMR via its Action Packages. We plan to organise some dialogue sessions addressing issues surrounding these topics, and we are happy to seek further collaboration with you.
