AIM & ACTIVITIES

The goal of the ASEFClassNet16 School Collaboration on "Leading Change: Digital Transformation of Education in the Era of Al" is to enable its participants to build awareness, basic competencies, and teaching and learning activities around Al&ED. To achieve this, the virtual capacity building phase of the programme is designed with various thematic, individual, and peer-to-peer pedagogical capacity-building opportunities.

In total, it consists of 8 sessions and an independent team activity phase. The programme starts with an official introduction, then it conducts training and learning activities in 3 phases over a period of 2 months (June – August 2023):

- 1) Self-Learning Phase | 4 Thematic Sessions
- 2) Team-Learning and |2 Peer-to-Peer Sessions
- 3) Action-Learning | Designing an "Innovative Teaching Practice" in groups of 3-5 teachers

After these 3 phases, the virtual capacity building programme closes with an Evaluation & Feedback session.

At the end of this Collaboration, we hope that participant teachers will walk away with essential knowledge on the topic to enhance their teaching and learning.


Self-Learning Phase | Learning from Experts

08 June 2023 - 06 July 2023 | 4 weeks

The **Self-learning Phase consists of 4 thematic webinars** (online lectures followed by discussions with subject experts). These sessions will provide participants with a solid knowledge foundation on the topic.

➤ The Teaching of Al in education (Al Literacy): building awareness, knowledge, and competencies of both the human and technological dimensions of Al, to understand what Al is and what it is not, how it works and how to create it, and its social, ethical, and human implications.

Applications of AI in education (AIED): building knowledge and understanding to critically evaluate the relevant use of AI and issues that concern the use of AI such as purpose, pedagogy, privacy, security, and ethics.

Thematic Webinar 1 | What is Al? What it is Not! & What is Al&ED? What is AlED?

This Session will focus on introducing participants to the concept and definition of what exactly is Al and what it is not. It will also introduce participants to what Al&ED and AlED means, and the larger role Al technologies play in transforming Education systems as well as teaching and learning practices.

 Peer-to-Peer Session 2 | Ideation & Discussion on Designing Innovative Teaching Practices

During this Session participants will come together to jointly work together in teams to discuss ideas and brainstorm for ITP design. While participants will be working in pairs, they will have an opportunity to listen to each other's ideas and share feedback to support one another to create effective and meaningful ITP on AIED/AI&ED.

Action-Learning Phase | Designing "Innovative Teaching Practices"

1 - 31 August 2023 | 4 Weeks

In this phase, participants will work in teams of 2-3 on a selected theme to design "Innovative Teaching Practices". The purpose of this phase is to ensure that participants gain a deeper understanding of the topic and develop self-awareness and pedagogical capacities in holistic teaching practices through active participation and engagement with their peers.

The "Innovative Teaching Practices" (ITPs) must be designed in a way that can either be implemented in the teachers own classroom or in the whole school environment. ITPs must also be innovative in a way that they contribute to raising awareness on AIED/AI&ED topics in general as well as applications of various AIED tools.
