


► **PARTICIPATION IN POLICY EVENTS**

2025: Year 2: Capacity Building and Dialogue Events | March-October 2025 | Online and Onsite

Based on the outputs of 2024, ARC10 activities in 2025 will primarily focus on a series of policy dialogues to bring the ARC10 report consisting of the thematic papers closer to ASEF's partners and stakeholders.

We aim to build on partnerships with key global players such as WAHEN, SEAMEO RIHED, the ASEM Education Secretariat, and the EG on the SDGs and Education guided by ARC10's themes.

Through these policy dialogues, we will work in close collaboration with the ASEM Education Process Expert Groups and Stakeholders and gather policy recommendations with the aim of forwarding these to the ASEM Education Ministers.
