As a part of the ASEF Classroom Network (ASEFClassNet) Faculty Collaboration programme, the International AIED Symposium will be held in Zhuhai, China, on Friday, 14 November 2025. - **Language:** English
- **Abstract:** 250-350 words abstract
- **Keywords:** 3-5 keywords
- **Text Format:** Times New Roman, font size 12 pt., with 1.5 line spacing
- **Length:** The total length of manuscripts should range between 5,000 and 8,000 words. The manuscript should have a clear and coherent structure, including Introduction, Theoretical Framework/Background, Methodology/Design, Results/Implementation, Discussion/Analysis, Conclusion/Implications, and References.
- **Reference:** Citations and references should follow the APA Style (7th edition)
